On March 5, 2014, the General Assembly of the PNC held a Brown Act noticed public meeting and passed the following motion:

Whereas the Palms Neighborhood Council acknowledges the possibility of the closure of the Santa Monica Airport (SMO). And Whereas a public park utilizing sustainable native landscaping would not only solve today's stakeholder concerns regarding airport-related air pollution and safety, but would offer very much needed open space to stakeholders from Los Angeles and Santa Monica.
